

Beginning NT Greek - Chapter 8: Homework

- Below is a suggested list of steps for doing your homework this week.
- Plan on spending a *minimum* of 30 minutes five days a week to complete everything.
- Try to establish a block of time every day at the same time and work through the material systematically.
- Don't cram all your studying (especially memory work) on the last day!

I. Mounce, Grammar:

A. Study Chap. 8: "Prepositions"

1. Memorize the paradigm for εἰμί on page 58.
2. Practice writing out the vocabulary words on pages 60-61. Say them as you write them out.
 - a. For prepositions, be sure to memorize the case with the meaning.
 - b. Example: When memorizing διὰ, say: "διὰ plus the genitive is 'through;' διὰ plus the accusative is 'on account of.'"

II. Mounce, Workbook:

- A. Do Exercise 8: "Prepositions" on pages 21-24.

III. EXTRA

- A. Write out the following Bible Memory Verses and memorize in Greek and in English. Pay careful attention to breathings and accent marks.
