Romans 1:17a

δικαιοσύνη γὰρ θεοῦ ἐν αὐτῷ ἀποκαλύπτεται ἐκ πίστεως εἰς πίστιν

δικαιοσύνη, ἡ- F,N,S, *righteousness*

ἀποκαλύπτω- 3-S,Pres,Pass,Ind, *revealed*

ἐκ πίστεως εἰς πίστιν- NAS: *from [by] faith to faith* NIV: *by faith from first to last*

17 For in the gospel a righteousness from God is revealed, a righteousness that is by faith from first to last
