1 - 3	Jan. 5 - Jan. 19	Galatians 6:2 Ἐλλήλων τὰ βάρη βαστάζετε καὶ οὕτως ἀναπληρώσετε τὸν νόμον τοῦ Χριστοῦ.  βάρος, ους, τό- N,A,P, <i>weight, burden</i> , only fig. βαστάζω- 2-P,Pres,Act,Impvt, <i>take up, carry, bear</i> ἀναπληρόω- 2-P,Fut,Act,Ind, <i>(and in this manner) you will make complete, fulfill</i> <i>Carry each other's burdens, and in this way you will fulfill the law of Christ.</i>
6 - 8	Jan. 26 - Feb. 9	Romans 8:1-2 1 Οὐδὲν ἄρα νῦν κατάκριμα τοῖς ἐν Χριστῷ Ἰησοῦ. 2 ὁ γὰρ νόμος τοῦ πνεύματος τῆς ζωῆς ἐν Χριστῷ Ἰησοῦ ἠλευθέρωσέν σε ἀπὸ τοῦ νόμου τῆς ἁμαρτίας καὶ τοῦ θανάτου.  οὐδεῖς, οὐδεμία, οὐδέν- <i>adj N,N,S, no, no one, none</i> used as a predicate adjective: <i>there is no [then now] NIV: Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ</i> κατάκριμα, ατος, τό- N,N,S, prob. not 'condemnation', but the punishment following sentencing, <i>punishment, doom</i> NAS & NIV: <i>condemnation</i> πνεῦμα, ατος, τό- N,G,S, <i>(for the law) of the spirit</i> ζωή, ῆς, ἡ- F,G,S, <i>(spirit of) life</i> ἠλευθέρω- 3-S,Aor,Act,Ind, <i>freed, set (you) free</i> <i>Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus, 2 because through Christ Jesus the law of the Spirit of life set me free from the law of sin and death.</i>
9 - 10	Feb. 16 - Mar. 9	Ephesians 2:10 αὐτοῦ γὰρ ἔσμεν ποίημα, κτισθέντες ἐν Χριστῷ Ἰησοῦ ἐπὶ ἔργοις ἀγαθοῖς οἷς προητοίμασεν ὁ θεὸς ἵνα ἐν αὐτοῖς περιπατήσωμεν.,  ποίημα, ατος, τό- N,N,S, <i>(for we are His) what is made, work, creation</i> NAS & NIV: <i>workmanship</i> κτίζω- M,N,P,Aor,Pass,Ptc, <i>created</i> ἐπὶ- prep + dat: here for purpose/result: <i>for (good works)</i> προετοιμάζω- 3-S,Aor,Act,Ind, <i>(which God) prepared beforehand, in advance</i> περιπατέω- 1-P,Aor,Act,Sub, <i>we might walk (in them = the good works)</i>  <i>For we are God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.</i>
