1. List the five rules for μι verbs. (5 points)

Rule 1: μι verbs reduplicate their initial stem letter to form the present, and separate the reduplicated consonant with an iota.

Rule 2: μι verbs do not ordinarily use a connecting (i.e., “thematic”) vowel in the indicative.

Rule 3: μι verbs employ three different personal endings in the present active indicative.

Rule 4: the stem vowel of μι verbs can lengthen, shorten, or drop out (about).

Rule 5: Most of the μι verbs use κα as their tense formative in the aorist.

2. Write out the complete paradigm for δίδωμι. (31 points, ½ point each)
