

Set Phrases

A “set phrase” is a combination of words that can be thought of as a unit. Here are several that are common in the New Testament.

καὶ λέγει αὐτῷ, Ἀμήν ἀμήν λέγω ὑμῖν. . . –

τοὺς ἀγγέλους τοῦ θεοῦ –

τὸν υἱὸν τοῦ ἀνθρώπου –

John 1:51 καὶ λέγει αὐτῷ, Ἀμήν ἀμήν λέγω ὑμῖν, ὄψεσθε τὸν οὐρανὸν ἀνεωγόμενον καὶ τοὺς ἀγγέλους τοῦ θεοῦ ἀναβαίνοντας καὶ καταβαίνοντας ἐπὶ τὸν υἱὸν τοῦ ἀνθρώπου.

ἡ μαρτυρία τοῦ Ἰωάννου –

John 1:19 Καὶ αὕτη ἐστὶν ἡ μαρτυρία τοῦ Ἰωάννου, . . .

τὸ φῶς τῶν ἀνθρώπων –

John 1:4 ἐν αὐτῷ ζωὴ ἦν, καὶ ἡ ζωὴ ἦν τὸ φῶς τῶν ἀνθρώπων.

Τῆ ἐπαύριον –

ὁ ἀμνὸς τοῦ θεοῦ –

τὴν ἁμαρτίαν τοῦ κόσμου –

John 1:29 Τῆ ἐπαύριον βλέπει τὸν Ἰησοῦν ἐρχόμενον πρὸς αὐτόν, καὶ λέγει, Ἴδε ὁ ἀμνὸς τοῦ θεοῦ ὁ αἴρων τὴν ἁμαρτίαν τοῦ κόσμου.

Σίμων ὁ υἱὸς Ἰωάννου –

John 1:42 . . . Σὺ εἶ Σίμων ὁ υἱὸς Ἰωάννου. . .

Ἰησοῦν υἱὸν τοῦ Ἰωσήφ τὸν ἀπὸ Ναζαρέτ –

John 1:45 . . . Ἰησοῦν υἱὸν τοῦ Ἰωσήφ τὸν ἀπὸ Ναζαρέτ.

ἀπεκρίθη ὁ Ἰησοῦς –

κύριος ὁ θεὸς ἡμῶν –

κύριος εἷς ἐστίν –

Mark 12:29 ἀπεκρίθη ὁ Ἰησοῦς . . . Ἄκουε, Ἰσραήλ, κύριος ὁ θεὸς ἡμῶν κύριος εἷς ἐστίν,
